4. BlindShell Classic (\$349)

- Voice dictation (email and text)
- Voice control
- Physical keyboard

5. Kisa (\$194 via kisaphone.com/au)



- No screen or keypad (may look like a toy but used as an emergency phone, pressing name of person to call and "call" button)
- On the front are up to 10 programmable buttons and names/photos of contacts (customize at time of purchase)
- High contrasting colors on front of phone
- Calls can only last for 15 minutes at a time
- Braille options available
- Emergency services button on back to contact 911 in case of injury
- Information about the phone's owner can be printed on the back (medical conditions, address, allergies, etc)
