Write a Letter to Santa - in Braille

LANCASTER, Penna. (Nov. 16, 2022) – Children are invited to use Braille to write a letter to Santa – and send it to VisionCorps. They will receive a reply from Santa – also in Braille (because Santa knows Braille, it's one of his many talents!).

This is a fun way to practice using Braille! Children will write their letters and then receive a letter back that they will be able to read.

VisionCorps' chief elf, Erika, will retrieve the letters and work with Santa to respond, in Braille, to each letter writer.
