Send Letters to Santa - in Braille

(LANCASTER, Penna.) Nov. 29, 2024 – Children of all ages are invited to write to Santa in braille. This tradition of writing letters to Santa in braille and getting a return note from Santa in braille is open now at <u>VisionCorps</u>.

"This ageless tradition of writing a letter to Santa is available to children who are blind or vision-impaired," said Dennis Steiner, VisionCorps president and CEO.

"We invite children to send their letters to Santa and tell him why they deserve to be on the 'nice list,'" said Steiner. "Each letter will receive a response back from Santa, also in braille."

Individuals – of all ages – who want to write to Santa in braille are also invited to participate, said Steiner.

"This is a great opportunity to practice writing and reading in braille," said Steiner. "It doesn't matter where you live – if you want to contact Santa Claus and send a note in braille, you can mail it to us, and we'll make sure that Santa sees it."
